Friendly Reminder

Child care fees are based on 50 hours of care per week and a premium fee of \$5.00 per hour is charged for hours that exceed 50 hours, however, care for each child may not exceed 12 hour per day, as established by OSD. Management will assist you in tracking usage and alert you if you utilize care beyond 12 hours. Continual usage beyond 12 hours will result in Command notification and will subject you to dis-enrollment. In the event that mission requirement dictate the need for care beyond 12 hours CYP will forward notification to the MCB Hawaii Commanding Officer to seek approval to offer care above the maximum hours. Command endorsement will be needed to verify mission requirement.

SAC fees are due the first and the 15th of every month. A late fee of \$10.00 per day will be charged for all fees accepted after the 3rd grace period day. For example, fees are due on the 1st, the 2nd, 3rd and 4th are grace period days. On the 5th and 6th days you will be charged \$10.00 late fees. At the close of business on the 6th day your child will automatically be disenrolled for non-payment of fees.
