

Borrowing Materials

How do I get a library card?

You must present a current military ID to get a card.

Library cards are available to all active duty military, DoD civilians, retirees and their dependents.

How many items can I check out?

There is no limit for books.

DVDs, CDs, audiobooks: ten per library card.
Video games, board games, tablets and kits: two per library card.

How long can I keep my library materials?

21 days. If no one has requested them, you can renew them.

To renew online, visit library.usmc-mccs.org>catalog>my account and enter your library card number and PIN.

How do I return my materials?

You can return materials in the library. There is also an outside book return located near the parking lot.

What are your overdue fees?

We do not charge overdue fees, but we do send notices. The first three go to you, and the fourth goes to your SgtMaj.
