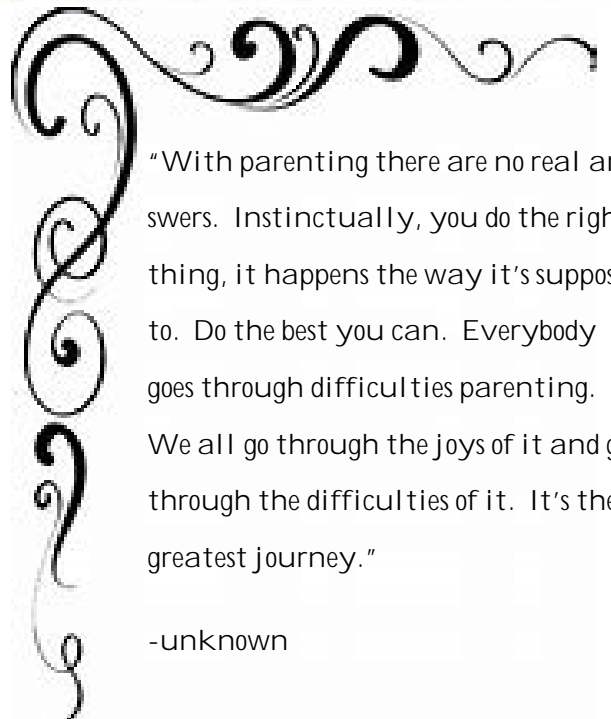
4th of July Safety Tips for Kids

- * Have a fire extinguisher readily available. This way if there is an accidental fire, the fire can be put out quickly.
- * Have water buckets or a hose available to eliminate any leftover embers or hot spots in the grass from fireworks.
- * Alcohol is a favorite for the holiday celebrations. However, it is important to keep alcohol out of the reach of children. There is a potential risk of alcohol poisoning.
- * Some decorations have smaller parts. It is important to make sure that decorations are properly secured in lower areas where children can reach. Smaller decorations pose a choking or strangulation hazard for young children.
- * Make sure that the area you are lighting fireworks off is free of bushes, dry grass, trees, streamers, balloons, flammable helium, and other fire hazardous materials.
- * When you are disposing of 4th of July decorations and fireworks, make sure that they are completely free of heat and fire. This way there will not be a smoldering fire after the party is over.
- * Safety includes removing small pieces of balloons, fireworks, and other items that are able to choke small children.
- * Stay away from illegal fireworks. They are illegal due to the increased danger involved with certain types of fireworks

Don't  Forget!

- * A 2 week written notice and payment is required for disenrollment from the program. If written notice is not received, no refund will be given for prepaid childcare. Your child's payment for their final 2 weeks will be required and if necessary pro-rated for the month.
- * Parents must check their child in and out at the reception desk, and in the classroom. Each CYP facility conducts 100% ID checks and parents are required to show identification at the front desk and in the classroom daily, regardless of time of drop-off or pick-up.
