Subj: ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH/ HEALTH CARDS

1. As of 05 January 2015 Preventive Medicine will no longer require health cards for food operations.
2. Due to the implication of the Tri-Service Food Code per section 2-201.11 the Person In Charge (PIC) will now be responsible for medical screening of employees. The PIC shall require food employees and conditional employees to report information about their health and activities as they relate to diseases that are transmissible through food. All employees shall report the information in a manner that allows the PIC to reduce the risk of food of foodborne disease transmission. Including and providing necessary information, such as date of onset of symptoms and illness as referenced in enclosure 1. All employees will sign and date enclosure 2 as an agreement and understanding.
