## American Red Cross Volunteer Application Process

Thank you for your interest in becoming a volunteer!

Please use the link below to begin the application process:

- Scroll down until you see a section titled “Services to the Armed Forces” under “Getting Started”.
- Look for “Volunteer at Tripler or Schofield Barracks” and click on “Volunteer Application”
- Follow the instructions to complete the application
- Upload your photo ID
- Authorize the background check

The background check usually takes about 1-7 business days. Once that is done, you will be contacted to register for orientation.

**General volunteer requirements** – forms and instructions will be provided at orientation:

- Red Cross Orientation – normally the last Friday of each month from 0900-1200.
- Tripler orientation – normally Monday and Tuesday of the week following Red Cross orientation. Volunteers must attend all of Day 1 and the first half of Day 2.
- Admissions Office to get set up in DEERS (must be done before going to Occupational Health)
- Occupational Health (Immunization) Screening.
- On-line HIPAA training.
- Volunteer Position Acceptance Statement signed by a supervisor in the area you will be working.
- Credentials (not required for non-medical volunteers).
- Volunteer badge – this will be the last step before you can start volunteering. You will get the badge form only after all other requirements have been met.

**Additional requirements for participants in the Human Animal Bond (HAB) program:**

- Canine Good Citizen Test (go to the AKC website for test info).
- Veterinary health clearance and temperament test (details will be provided).
- An accompanied walk-through with another dog handler.
